American Structurepoint has provided architecture and engineering services for the recently opened **Indianapolis-Marion County Community Justice Campus** on the southeast side of Indianapolis. The campus houses the Marion County Superior Court, Marion County Circuit Court, Marion County Sheriff's Office, Adult Detention Center, and Assessment and Intervention Center.

American Structurepoint joined a design-build team led by AECOM Hunt to design the Adult Detention Center and Marion County Sheriff's Office. American Structurepoint designed the structural components of the Adult Detention Center, Marion County Sheriff's Office, and Central Utility Plant. We also provided exterior architectural services for the 3-story, 83,000-square-foot Sheriff's Office and led the architectural design of the Central Utility Plant.

The 3,000-bed, 5-story Adult Detention Center offers physical and mental health services for inmates, including

modern medical facilities and enhanced addiction treatment. Video conferencing in each housing unit gives inmates the ability to participate in virtual hearings, counseling sessions, and private meetings.

In parallel with this project, American Structurepoint also provided a traffic analysis and designed road improvements around the facility to enhance traffic flow for the City of Indianapolis Department of Public Works. Our civil engineers are designing the site for two parking structures on the campus grounds, and our utility infrastructure team oversaw the hydraulic analysis of a new pedestrian bridge over Pleasant Run.
