American Structurepoint's architects, interior designers, and structural engineers have designed the renovations for **Westminster Village of West Lafayette**. The renovation includes an upgrade to the social center, the front lobby and seating/bistro area, the pub, the dining room, and a community room. American Structurepoint has also contributed to a major renovation of one of the residential towers on the campus, where a memory care unit with 14 suites is being added. In addition, 17 independent living apartments are being converted into 21 assisted living apartments, and renovations are being made to common areas and amenities.

American Structurepoint took an immersive approach to the design, inviting staff and residents to use virtual reality to see what the renovation will look like when complete and experience in real time the vision for the upgraded campus, including changes in the finishes, furniture, and amenities.

American Structurepoint met with residents and staff at Westminster Village on numerous occasions to discuss the design and how it could improve the quality of life for residents. This feedback was extremely beneficial to the overall design process.

A groundbreaking ceremony for Westminster Village was held at the campus on May 18th. West Lafayette Mayor John Dennis and Indiana State Representative Sheila Klinker attended along with members of our American Structurepoint team. Construction on the facility has started and is expected to be complete by January 2023.
