PROPERTY CONDITION ASSESSMENTS

A property condition assessment (PCA) consists of a thorough review of the overall physical condition of a property and/or building, its systems, and components to help prospective buyers understand how these conditions will impact their bottom line. Systems and components in a typical PCA include:

- Overall site
- Structural integrity and major framing components of the building and roof system
- Architectural components, including exterior cladding and interior finishes
- Accessibility (ADA), building code violations, and life safety compliance
- Mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and fire protection systems
